

Introduction

This statement has been published in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (“Act”) and sets out the steps that Global Draw Limited and Barcrest Group Limited (together “SG”, “We”, “Our”) has taken during the financial year ending December 2016 to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within any part of Our business and supply chain. SG carries out business in the United Kingdom in the gaming sector operating from offices in Manchester, Wolverhampton and London.

Background

SG is part of the Scientific Games Corporation group of companies (“Scientific Games”) headquartered in Las Vegas. Scientific Games is a leading innovator in the global lottery and regulated gaming industries. Beginning with breakthrough technology that launched the world’s first secure instant lottery game in 1974. Scientific Games has continued to advance the games, technology, programs, marketing research and security that has been a driving force behind the success of more than 300 customers on six continents over the last 40 years. Scientific Games has over 8000 employees worldwide, and serves customers from advanced-technology manufacturing and operational facilities in North America, South America, Europe and Asia, with additional facilities located throughout America and around the world based on customer requirements. Scientific Games continues to innovate with patented gaming technology and research-driven programs delivered to customers with the highest level of security, integrity and ethical standards.

Approach to modern slavery and human trafficking

Operating in a heavily regulated sector, We are unswerving in Our approach to compliance and intolerance to human rights violations including modern slavery and human-trafficking. SG is committed to working with its suppliers to reduce risk of modern slavery and human trafficking within its supply chain. SG has robust compliance procedures and checks which are carried out prior to on boarding and contracting with any new supplier.

Moreover, SG requires all its suppliers to sign up to the [Scientific Games Code of Conduct](#) (“Code of Conduct”), all suppliers are encouraged to conduct their business to standards set out in the Code of Conduct as a minimum. SG reserves the right to refuse to appoint or work with any supplier whose operation and or supply chain fails to comply with the requirements stated in the Code of Conduct and or any law or regulation.

Effectiveness and Future Proofing

SG is committed to meeting its obligations under the Act and has a focused approach in ensuring its obligations have been met. SG will continue to work with the rest of Scientific Games to combat the risk modern slavery and human trafficking. Whilst SG has a number of policies and procedures in place to combat modern slavery and human trafficking, We know that there is much more to be done.



Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement June 2017

SG understands that risk and exposure to modern slavery is not static and may evolve as the business evolves. SG will continue to mitigate this risk in the year ahead, and will seek new and innovative ways to ensure We are meeting our commitment to combat modern slavery and human trafficking.

SG will use the following key performance indicators and report on them in future Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statements:

- Development and publication of new Supplier Guidelines;
- Actions taken to strengthen supply chain auditing and verification;
- Increase awareness of modern slavery and human trafficking within Scientific Games and Our supply chain;
- Steps taken to upskill and improve the operations of high risk suppliers, and assessing their ability to detect and mitigate modern slavery risks in their operations and supply chain; and
- Investigations and remedial action taken in response to reports of incidences of modern slavery and human trafficking.
